Like so many of you, we have spent the last several days and weeks learning as much as we can about the [COVID-19 \(coronavirus\)](#) and how it is impacting, not only our country, but our community. For [Power Ranch](#), its [Board of Directors](#) and [CCMC](#), that means understanding how it affects, our residents, our staff, our vendor partners and our guests, and then making the necessary adjustments to our work and operations.

In order to be responsive to this current, albeit temporary, situation the following safety protocols have been initiated effective immediately: the Carriage House, the Ranch House and the Barn have been closed to all clubs, classes and groups until further notice.

The leaders of these clubs and classes have been contacted individually regarding this change and given the opportunity to move these sessions outdoors, temporarily pause them, or find an alternative location. Please look for communication directly from your individual instructor or host regarding schedule and location changes. At this time, the Association is not accepting new reservations for any indoor spaces or meeting rooms. There will also be some changes to our normal active lifestyle calendar so please keep reading as we share our plan for maintaining a strong sense of community.

We are not insensitive to the disruption this creates for our residents but please understand this decision was made in absolute deference to our most important community asset, its people.

Regardless of this temporary change in programming, the [Power Ranch mission](#) is to create the highest level of community living, especially in trying times like these. For those of you who attended the Annual meeting, you may remember the message of balance and opportunity. That means even during these times of heightened concern and risk prevention/minimization, we believe in the power of community! Power Ranch will continue to shine as the best community in the East Valley. Although, there will be a temporary disruption to the Lifestyle Calendar, we are diligently working on alternative planning for the weeks ahead.

Our [Eggstra Festival](#) on April 4 has been cancelled. However, in its place, we are creating opportunities for individual neighborhoods to host mini Eggstra events in their pocket parks. The Lifestyle team will be assembling a "Party in a Bag" for neighborhood hosts to pick up and use. There are many details for this particular

plan, which we will share on the registration page, should you be interested. Alternative programming may include Yoga in the Park, Family Bike Rides, Kite Flying, and Fishing.

We encourage you to be socially responsible when you gather, such as choosing activities that do not require sharing of common items, as well as washing and sanitizing areas before and after use.
