Qualifications:

- Must currently attend high school within the Higley School District.
- Must currently be a Junior or Senior
- Must have a current GPA of 1.75 – 2.5

How to Apply:

- Submit a video of why you should be considered for one of the Cameron Kay Scholarships. The video should include your name, grade point average, and your plans and/or goals for the future. Video submittal must be made available either on YouTube or saved on a flash drive.
- Video submissions should be 90 – 180 seconds.
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher, advisor and/or family member must be submitted.
- Please include your name, email address and phone number on the above submittals.
